BOA Proposes Amendments to Rules and Regulations to comply with Act #2024-379

Governor Ivey signed BOA's housekeeping legislation into law on May 15, 2024. Act #2024 - 379 (located at https://arc-sos.state.al.us/ucp/L1547932.Al1.pdf) will become effective on October 1, 2024. Therefore, BOA is proposing amendments to Rules and Regulations to comply with this Act.

In summary, this legislation updates grammar/style and provides standard regulatory practices in keeping with most Boards in Alabama. This will specifically affect licensees by providing for the following:

- For the purpose of attracting Architects to the State of Alabama, The Board has the authority to waive renewal fees (if finances allow) for newly licensed Architects who reside in-state.
- Emeritus Architects will no longer be required to renew annually.
- Certificates of Authorization will now have a process to reinstate a lapsed license.
